The Teacher Librarian, together with the Library team, design and deliver effective and collaborative services and programs to enhance curriculum outcomes and ensure the day to day operation and running of the Library is well maintained.

We invite applications from suitably qualified and experienced teachers for this full time, contract position in our Library to commence as soon as possible to 13 December 2019.

Appropriate academic qualifications and teacher training, as well as a sound understanding of current educational trends and learning styles are required.

All teaching staff members are expected to take part in the whole life of the School including participation in pastoral care and involvement in co-curricular activities.

Eligibility for registration with the ACT Teacher Quality Institute which includes a Working with Vulnerable People check are conditions of employment. A current first aid certificate is desirable.
